04. Graduand and Guest Admission Cards:

The Graduand Admission Card and Guest Admission Card will be issued along with the convocation cloak. (Please refer to the cloak collection schedule available on the <u>University website</u>). Both the **Graduand** and their **guest** are required to present their respective **Admission Cards** to gain entry to the General Convocation -2025.

05. Guests of Graduands

- I. Only one guest per graduand will be admitted into the Convocation Hall.
- II. Children below 12 years will not be admitted into the Convocation Hall.
- III. Wide screen viewing facilities will be available outside the Convocation Hall for others.
- IV. All guests in the Convocation Hall are **kindly requested to remain seated** throughout the proceedings.
- V. For **security reasons**, graduands and their guests **will not be permitted** to bring cameras, suitcases, bags, mobile phones, or any other items into the Convocation Hall. These restrictions will be **strictly enforced**.
- VI. **Toilet and canteen facilities** will be available in close proximity to the Convocation Hall and parking areas.

06. Parking Information

Graduands' vehicles will not be permitted to enter the University Senate premises.

They will be requested to park their vehicles in the designated parking areas located near the Faculty of Arts & Culture and the Faculty of Commerce & Management.

07. Convocation Dress Code

- Male Graduands should wear a lounge suit or full National Costume.
- Female Graduands should wear a Saree or National Costume, with their hair styled formally so as not to obstruct the garlanding by the Chancellor.
- All Graduands are required to wear their respective Convocation Cloak over the appropriate attire.



Please ensure that your attire is neat and formal, in keeping with the dignity of the occasion.

08. Procedure for Conferment of Degrees

- I. Graduands will be presented by the Deans of their respective Faculties.
- II. When your name is announced, you must proceed to the front of the stage and present yourself to the Chancellor for the conferment of your degree.

 You should bow before the Chancellor, receive the garland, and then return to your seat quietly. Please remain seated until the conclusion of the ceremony.
- III. At the end of the ceremony, all graduates are required to stand when the Chancellor rises to declare the closure of the Convocation, and remain standing until the Chancellor's Procession exits the Convocation Hall.

<u>Marketian</u> Important: All graduates of the session must exit the Convocation Hall and its premises immediately after the session concludes to facilitate preparations for the next session.

Please note that studios will be established by the Authorized Photographer on the Convocation day to enable the graduates to take photographs outside the Convocation Hall.

10. Returning of Cloak & Garland:

Graduates are required to return the Convocation Cloak and Garland to the Academic Affairs Department, located at the Senate Building, on or before 22nd October 2025.

Those who fail to return the items by the deadline will be charged a late return fine of Rs. 500.00 per day.
